Praying towards Earth from Heaven, where we are seated with Christ Jesus


He who sits in the Heavens shall laugh...

The Holy Spirit's prayers

Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but **the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us** with groanings which cannot be uttered. Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

(Romans 8: 26-27; emphasis added)



What is our reality?

But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

Watch see write read run

I will stand my watch And set myself on the rampart, And watch to see what He will say to me, And what I will answer when I am corrected.

Then the Lord answered me and said:

"Write the vision And make it plain on tablets, That he may run who reads it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time; But at the end it will speak, and it will not lie..." (Habakkuk 2: 1-3)

What Heaven wants

The power of agreement

... by the mouth of two or three witnesses the matter shall be established.

(Deut. 19: 15b)

How could one chase a thousand, And two put ten thousand to flight...? (Deut. 32: 30)

.. And a threefold cord is not quickly broken. (*Eccl. 4: 12b*)

Why God needs our agreement

The heaven, even the heavens, are the Lord's;

But the earth He has given to the children of men.

(Psalm 115: 16: emphasis added)

Did Moses change God's mind?

Then the Lord said to Moses: "How long will these people reject Me? And how long will they not believe Me, with all the signs which I have performed among them? I will strike them with the pestilence and disinherit them, and I will make of you a nation greater and mightier than they."

And now, I pray, let the power of my Lord be great, just as You have spoken, saying, 'The Lord is longsuffering and abundant in mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression; but He by no means clears the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generation.' Pardon the iniquity of this people, I pray, according to the greatness of Your mercy, just as You have forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now."

Then the Lord said: "I have pardoned, according to your word; (Numbers 14: 11; 17-20)

Translation

God says, "If you don't pray, here is what is going to happen: these people will end up in destruction because of their sinful behaviour.

"But if, if I can get you to agree with Me for them not to be destroyed, then maybe together we can find a way towards a better outcome."

Prayer, the saddest verse

So I sought for a man among them who would make a wall, and stand in the gap before Me on behalf of the land, that I should not destroy it; **but I found no one**.

(Ezekiel 22: 30; emphasis added)

The big take away

- Listen to God as you start to pray and let Him direct your prayer.
- Be open to the prophetic.
